Funds to distribute solar motion lights.

## Xcel Energy Lighting Program for Alleys

Call: 1-800-960-6235 between 7:30 AM and 4:00 PM to request installation or for more information.

Three types of Lighting are available:

100 watt: \$7.18 + tax/ monthly

250 watt: \$11.81+tax/ monthly

400 watt: \$17.81+tax/ monthly

Most residents choose the 100 watt-but it's up to you

There is no charge for installation of the light which can take up to 8 weeks

After installation you will be billed monthly on your regular electric bill.

NOTE: If you are not the owner of your home, please contact the person who owns the property to request an alley light.

Remember if you pay the Xcel bill you may be responsible for the additional charges.
