Rice Street Visioning Presentation

Scott McBride gave an overview on the project background, design implementation and engagement strategies. The major themes are pedestrian and traffic safety, bicycle and transit facility operations and supporting the community through economic development, business vitality, public safety and livability. Concept B is the chosen design and recommends a three lane roadway with 11 foot thru lanes and a 10 foot turn lane, there is a six foot sidewalk with six feet of boulevard and a shared use path. There is a revised schedule of 2022-2023 preliminary final design and construction starts in 2024. There will be an open house on March 30th.
